<u>From Archive to Database: Reflections on the History of Laws Governing</u> <u>Access to Information, Seminar on Transparency</u> 25 October 2018



The imperative to provide access to information has necessitated the introduction of regulation that goes beyond the remit of traditional freedom of information laws. Such frameworks include laws governing access to personal data, including the recently enacted UK Data Protection Act and the EU General Data Protection Regulation, to open data laws, as in Germany and the U.S.

At the heart of this development in legislation, governing access to information lies a fundamental shift in the nature of information itself, from traditional paper documents to the data and Big Data of today.

The ILPC will be hosting an evening seminar to discuss these issues and to generate critical reflections on the historical development of access to information laws in their different permutations.


